2 X A/C 2610-Y Cobb jettisoned 1 bomb and returned 11.  
Remaining A/C Box "A" returned all bombs, adverse weather conditions PDF 1240

Low Box "B" CBW:

1 X Davidson A/C 2533-K returned 12 bombs - bomb rack malfunction,  
2 X A/C 7317-P Foster D.L. abort  
Primary target Mulhouse, France was not bombed  
Target of Opportunity: Gembloux, Belgium was bombed by remaining 12 A/C (PDF 1357)
