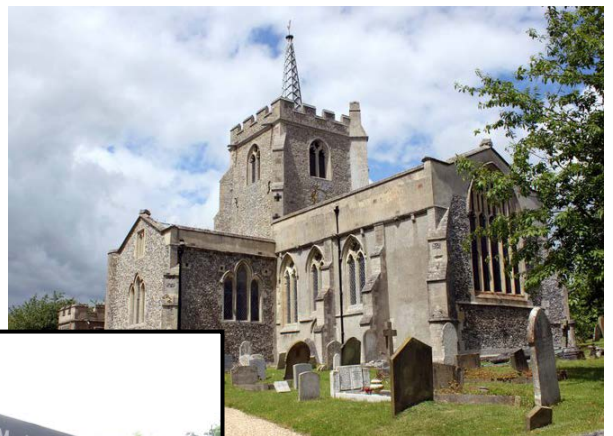

Robert Duncan Huey, Navigator, 1st Lt, 603rd SQ

In honor and remembrance of my father-in-law

I have always had great admiration for those of the 8th Army Air Force and the other services who have served and defended our nations, defending our freedom and country, during WWII. As part of that "greatest generation" Duncan, as others of his generation, did not discuss his part in that great war effort. I think that the readers of FLAK NEWS would have an interest in knowing that another member of their fellowship has passed away and enjoy reading about a part of his war time legacy. With each passing year the numbers of surviving members of that very select membership are rapidly diminishing and they should be remembered by all for their sacrifices.

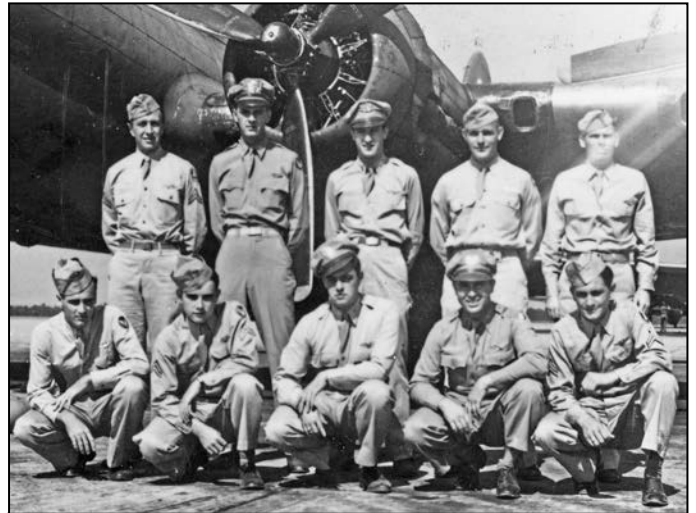
Robert Duncan Huey, age 94, was born on June 12, 1921 to John Howard Huey and Laura Porter Huey and passed away on June 25, 2015.

He married his high school sweetheart, Ruth Kottmyer Huey, just before entering WWII and they celebrated their 73rd anniversary a few weeks before his death.

After his discharge from the service, he earned his B.S. and M.A. degrees at Eastern Kentucky University. He retired from the Boone County Kentucky School System after 35 years and was a long-time Boone County educator and basketball coach. As he had requested, his pall bearers were members of his prior basketball teams from over 45 - 50 years ago. He was also a 50 year Masonic Lodge F&AM #757 member and was given final tribute by them as well as a military funeral service with gun salute by the VFW honor guard.

On December 15, 1942 he enlisted in the Army Air Corps and received his training and wings at Selman Field, Monroe, Alabama before being deployed overseas in August 1944 to Station 131 at Nuthampstead, England. While overseas, he served as a lead navigator on 16 of his 30 total missions, most of which were over Germany. Two of the missions were over France and one was over Czechoslovakia. He was awarded the Air Medal with 4 oak leaf clusters, European Theater Ribbon with 2 battle stars and a Presidential Unit Citation.

Duncan was an astute record keeper all his life and during the war he personally retained a bomb arming pin & tag from each of his bombing missions. He made notations of each mission on each tag and saved them away. Later in his life when he was in his eighties I would read some of his notations to him and he would reminisce and comment about his crew members or details of the mission. Each time he would always thank his pilot, Lt. Robert E. Steele, and his fellow crew members for the safe return to the home base after the long hours to Germany. Years ago, he gave the tags to his daughter along with his uniform and gas mask so that his grandson, Kevin, could preserve them and remember his efforts. He enjoyed reading the FLAK NEWS and I would periodically visit the www.398th.org website for articles of interest to him. He was pleased when I showed him a photo from the 398th web site that showed his actual plane (that was on loan from 601st SQ -s/n A/C 44-8771-30B) and was pictured in a photo taken by Lt. Bob Welty outside his side window on mission 146 to Prague [see photo on page 12]. This aircraft was used by Lt. Steele on both mission number 146 to Prague, Czechoslovakia and mission 157 to Neckarsulm, Germany.

A few of his hand written entries on the bomb tags note:

- *On mission #124 (his 12th mission) on 12/24/1944 (Christmas Eve) to Koblenz, Germany on aircraft A-7317-P he notes "lost engine at IP, blew up RR bridge and road, landed at Ridgewell, 18-100# bombs"*
- *On mission #128 (his 16th mission) on 1/1/1945 (New Year's day) to Madgeberg Kassel, Germany on aircraft - 8086-C he notes "3 ships explode at assembly, Pinner ditched in North Sea, heavy flax in Denmark & Germany, bomb Kassel, several big holes (in ship)"*
- *On mission #140 (his 20th mission) on 1/28/1945 to Cologne, Germany on aircraft -8533-Y PFF he notes "Lead to squad, major battle damage, Molesworth (his turret gunner) hit in arm"*

After serving his 30 missions, he then served as an instructor in England before returning to the United States. Following the end of the war, he was discharged on October 16, 1945 at Sioux Falls AAFld - Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

Duncan, with his wife Ruth, returned to Nuthampstead AF Base in England years ago with a tour group and he had the opportunity to show her rather than 'write home' as he did in wartime about his England home-away-from-home that he lived in during WWII.

He leaves behind a loving family in his wife Ruth, son Michael (Cindi) Huey, daughters Janis Kay Huey and Donna Sue Huey Walker as well as his grandson, Kevin L. Walker. He will be remembered for all of his accomplishments in life as well as those of WWII. I only hope that I can live up to just a small portion of his accomplishments. We will all miss him.

Upon passing away, Duncan will leave David E. Spelts presently of Florida as the last surviving member of that crew.

May God bless them all.
